 1. David, having been confronted with his sins of murder and adultery (2 Samuel 11), confessed them (2 Samuel 12:13a) and pleaded for God's forgiveness. Identify key words used by David in Psalm 51:1-3 to acknowledge his need for God's intervention.
2. David knew that he sinned against God. What did David say to show that he was at a low point in life (vv. 51:3-4)?
3. What does v. 51:5 say about the sinful nature of David? What does Romans 5:12 say about the sinful nature of all people?
4. David confessed his sins to God and repented. Describe the meaning of repentance and its relationship to God's forgiveness (v. 51:7, Acts 5:31, Luke 24:47).
5. Name the benefits of God's forgiveness sought by David (vv. 51:8-9, 11).
6. Considering that David's sin lingered for quite some time prior to his confession, of what significance is the request in v. 51:10 to his repentance? Does David give the impression that a repentant heart requires the supernatural help of God? How do we come by this help (v. 51:11, Romans 8:9)?
7. In return for forgiveness, what did David promise to God (v. 51:13)?
