

FOR CONVERSATION:

1. In the wake of Aaron leading the Israelites into sinful worship of a golden calf (Exodus 32), what did God say that caused Moses to worry about leading the Israelites to the Promised Land (Exodus 33:12-13)?
2. There was quite a contrast between Moses being on Mount Sinai receiving the Ten Commandments from God, and Aaron's idolatry. Name a core reality that caused such a difference in these two men. Hint: what of a personal nature did Moses have with God, but Aaron certainly lacked?
3. Moses took the initiative on the peoples' behalf to ask for God's mercy. What was Moses' specific request, and God's reply (vv. 14-17)?
4. Describe the responsibility that Moses exercised in seeking God's presence (vv. 13-18).
5. In light of Moses' relationship with God, should His presence in us be a priority?
6. How did Moses set the example for having a dynamic personal relationship with God? How important was his practice of unceasing prayer to the relationship (vv. 18-19, 1 Thessalonians 5:15)?
7. When Moses asked to see God's glory, what was His reply (vv. 17-20)? Why did Moses make this request?
